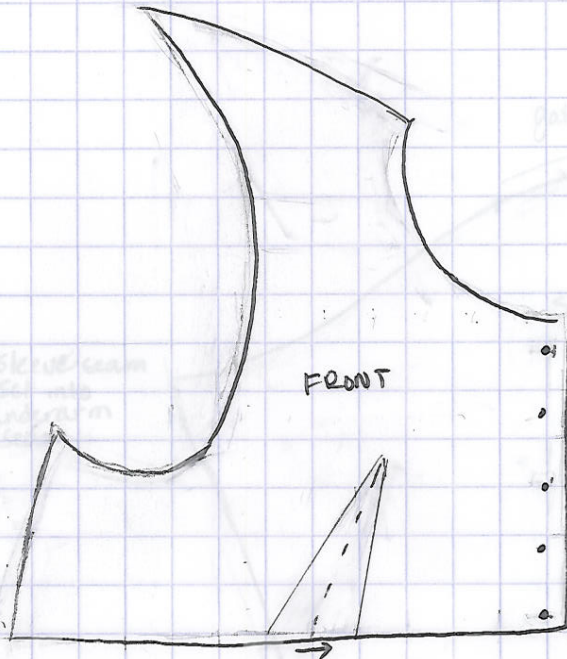
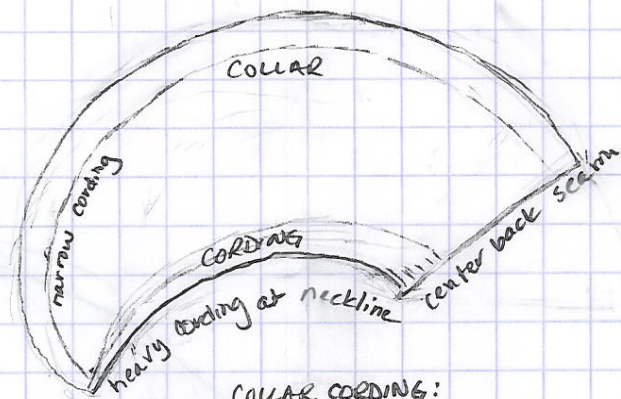


All seams are topstitched



← button/button hole placement

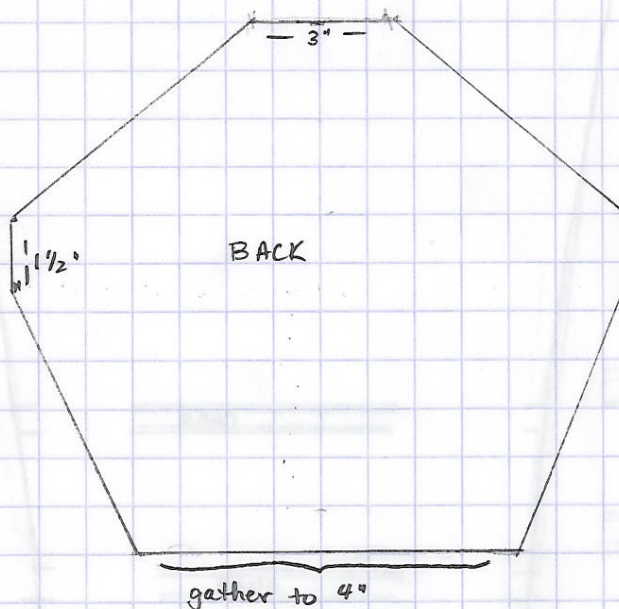
Buttons are 3/4 self fabric-covered disks. Button holes on L.H. side of jacket about 1" in length.

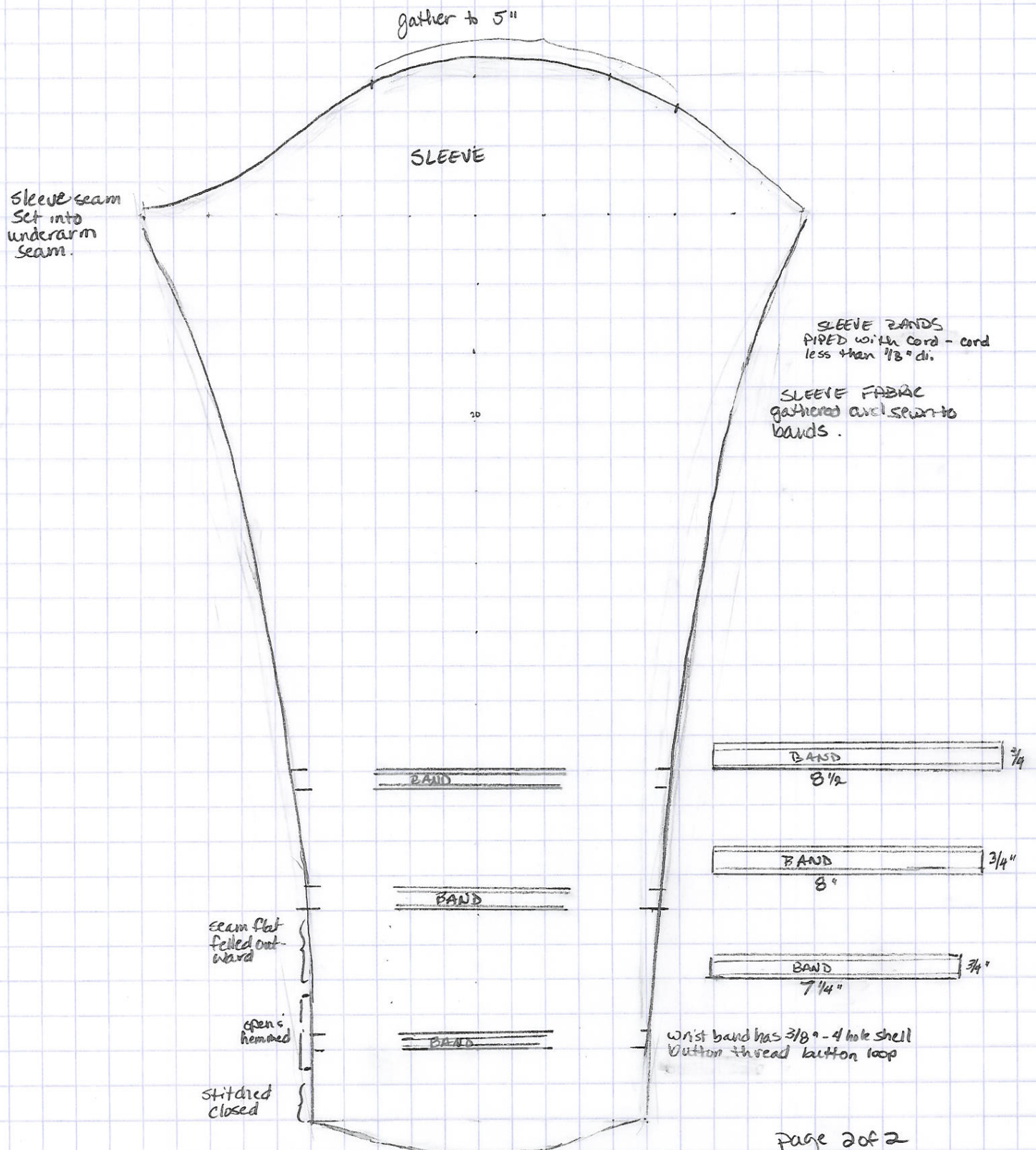


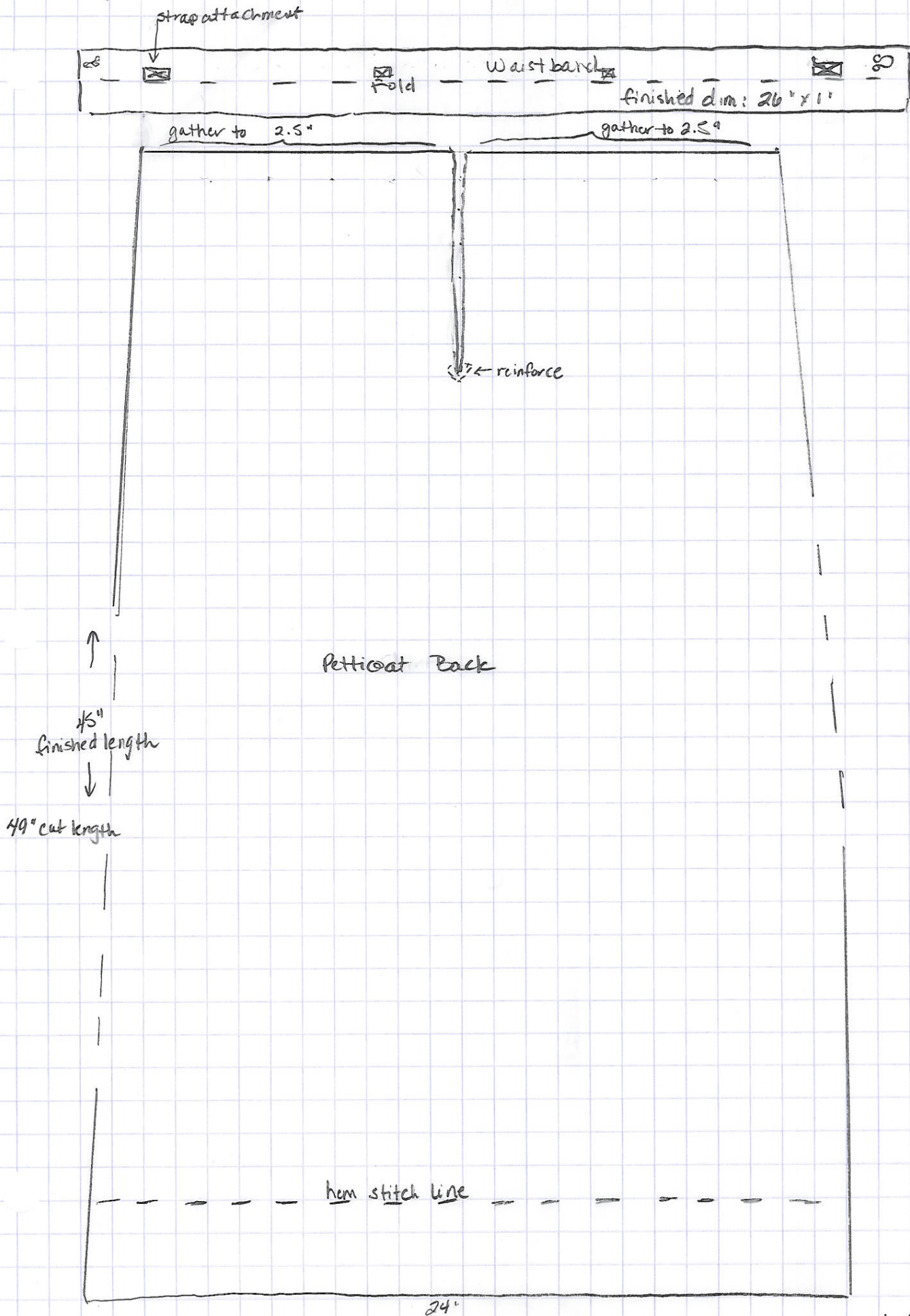
COLLAR CORDING: narrow cording laid in bands - up to 6" at center back.

Narrow cording set 1" from collar outside edge.

collar is lined in a different zigzag fabric. hem is doubled over on front and back, but open at edge. Collar and lining sewn together at edge trim cording - creates a kind of ruffle

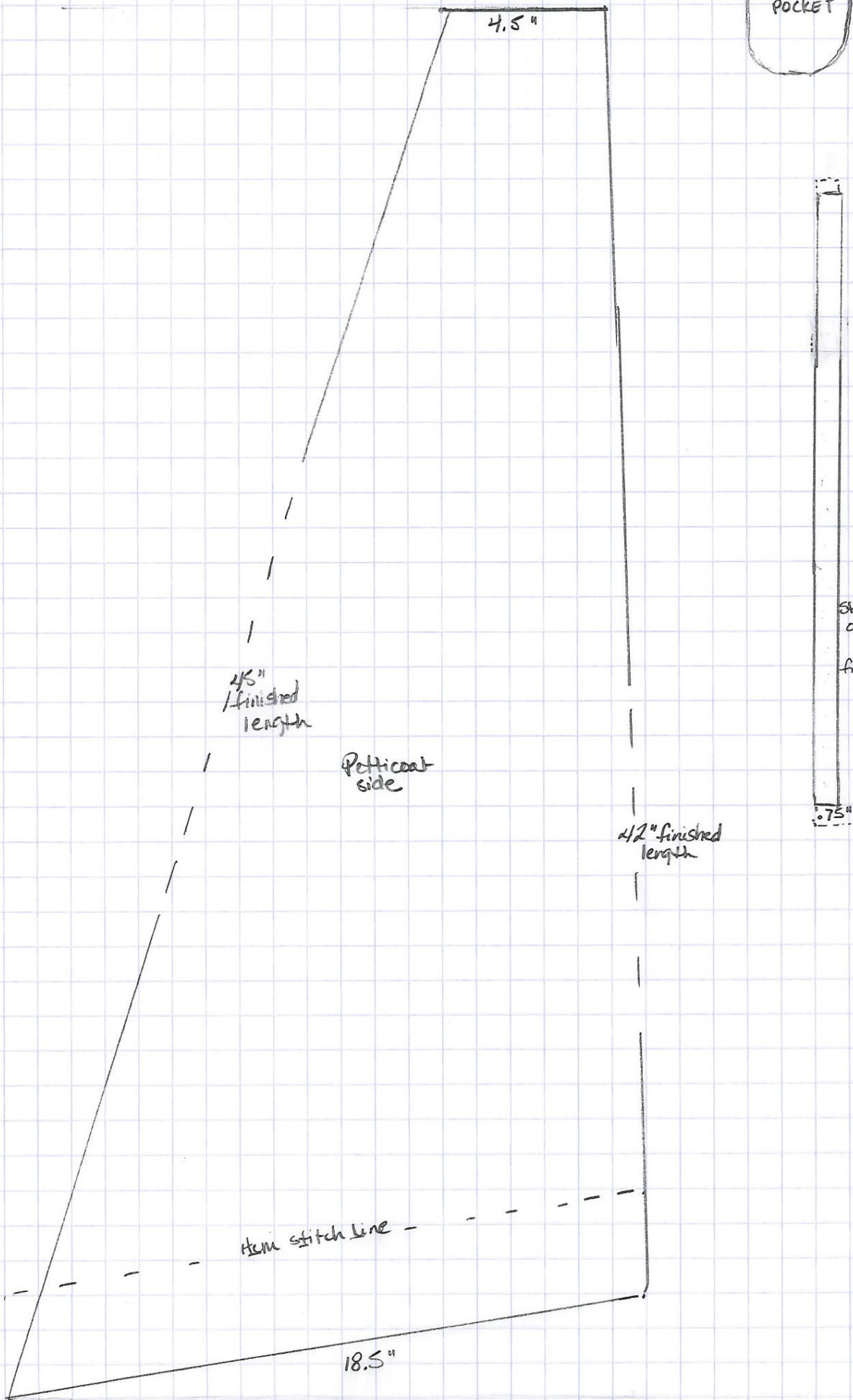






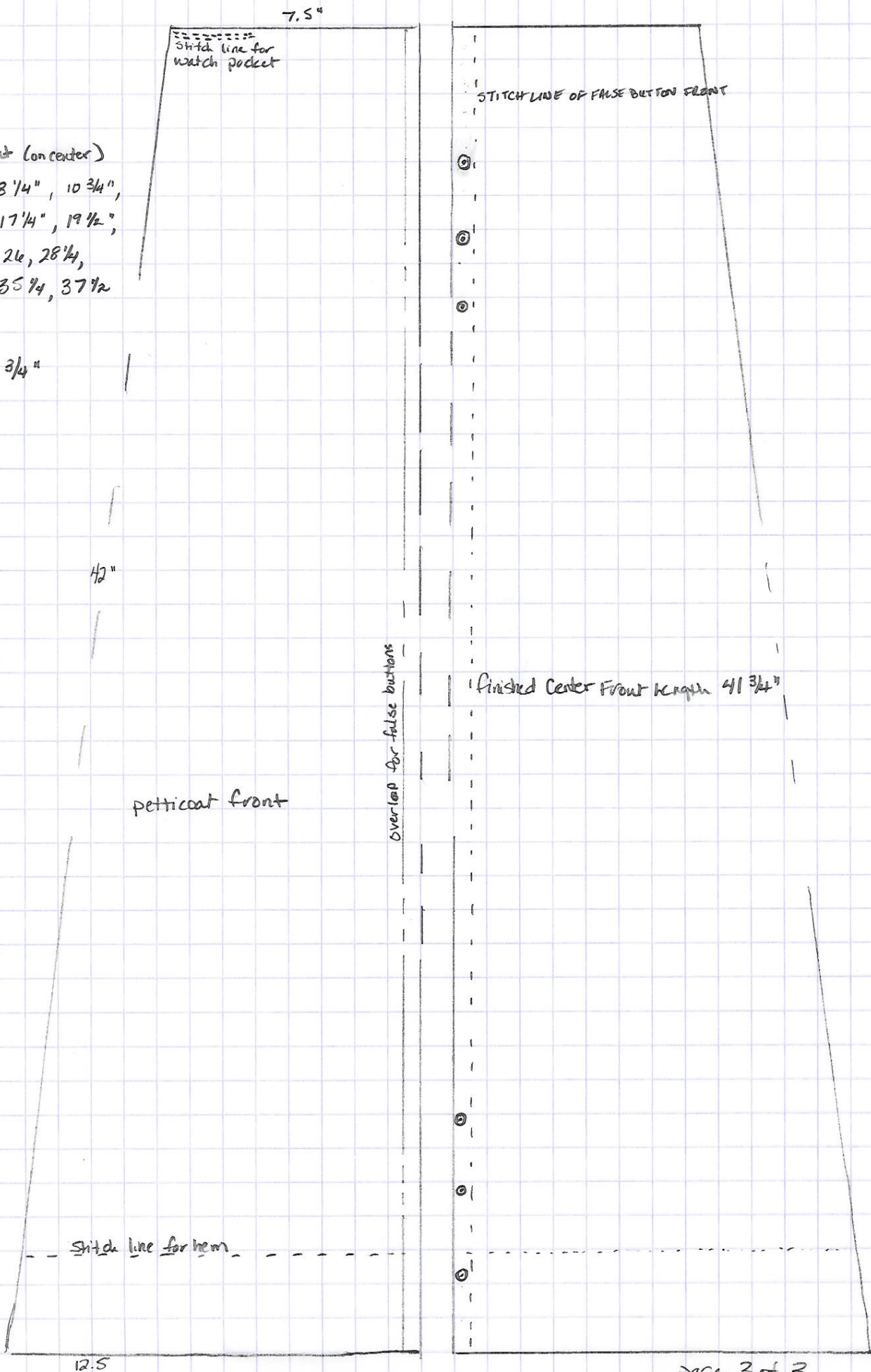

at piping.

Cape edged in narrow piping set at
 $\frac{3}{4}$ " from edge of cape.

Cape buttons with thread loop, 4-hole
 $\frac{3}{8}$ " shell buttons (matches spencer cuff)
